



## The Publications of Roger Walsh

Roger Walsh MD, Ph.D. graduated from Queensland University with degrees in psychology, physiology, neuroscience and medicine. He then came to the United States as a Fulbright scholar, passed licensing exams in medicine, psychology and psychiatry, and is currently professor of psychiatry, philosophy and anthropology, as well as adjunct professor of religious studies at the University of California at Irvine. His research and writings have received over two dozen national and international awards and honors while his teaching has received one national and six university awards. His publications include *The World of Shamanism*, *Paths Beyond Ego*, and *Essential Spirituality: The Seven Central Practices*. He was formerly a circus acrobat and recently tried to learn standup comedy, with limited success.
